

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish conditions and standards for the application of dust control for the benefit of private residences and / or businesses within the communities in the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne.

SUMMARY OF STANDARD

Dust control shall be limited to one application per year. Dust control shall be applied annually on or about the middle of June and be arranged and carried out under the supervision of the Manager of Operations.

Dust control shall be applied to the following roads as per attached maps:

Treherne:

1. On Road 42N (between roads 54W and 55W) from the west side of the bridge to 100 feet past the residences on Timmerman Trail.
2. Back lanes in business section of Treherne.
3. The back lane from Perrie Ave to the back entrance to the Municipal Office and two passes down the center of the Municipal Office parking lot.
4. Cottonwood Campground and entrance roads.

Rathwell:

1. King Street between Broadway Street and Monteith Street.
2. Garrick Street between Broadway Street and Monteith Street.
3. Monteith Street between Railway Street and Garrick Street.
4. Any other street returned to gravel base.

Lavenham:

1. Railway Ave between 1st Street and 2nd Street.
2. 1st Street between Railway Ave and Government Road Allowance.
3. 2nd Street between Railway Ave and Government Road Allowance.
4. 3rd Street between Railway Ave and Government Road Allowance.

The Manager of Operations will arrange for grading, gravelling and watering if applicable before the application of dust control.

All dust control is charged to Transportation Services, except for the dust control provided to the Cottonwood Campground, which is charged directly to the campground.

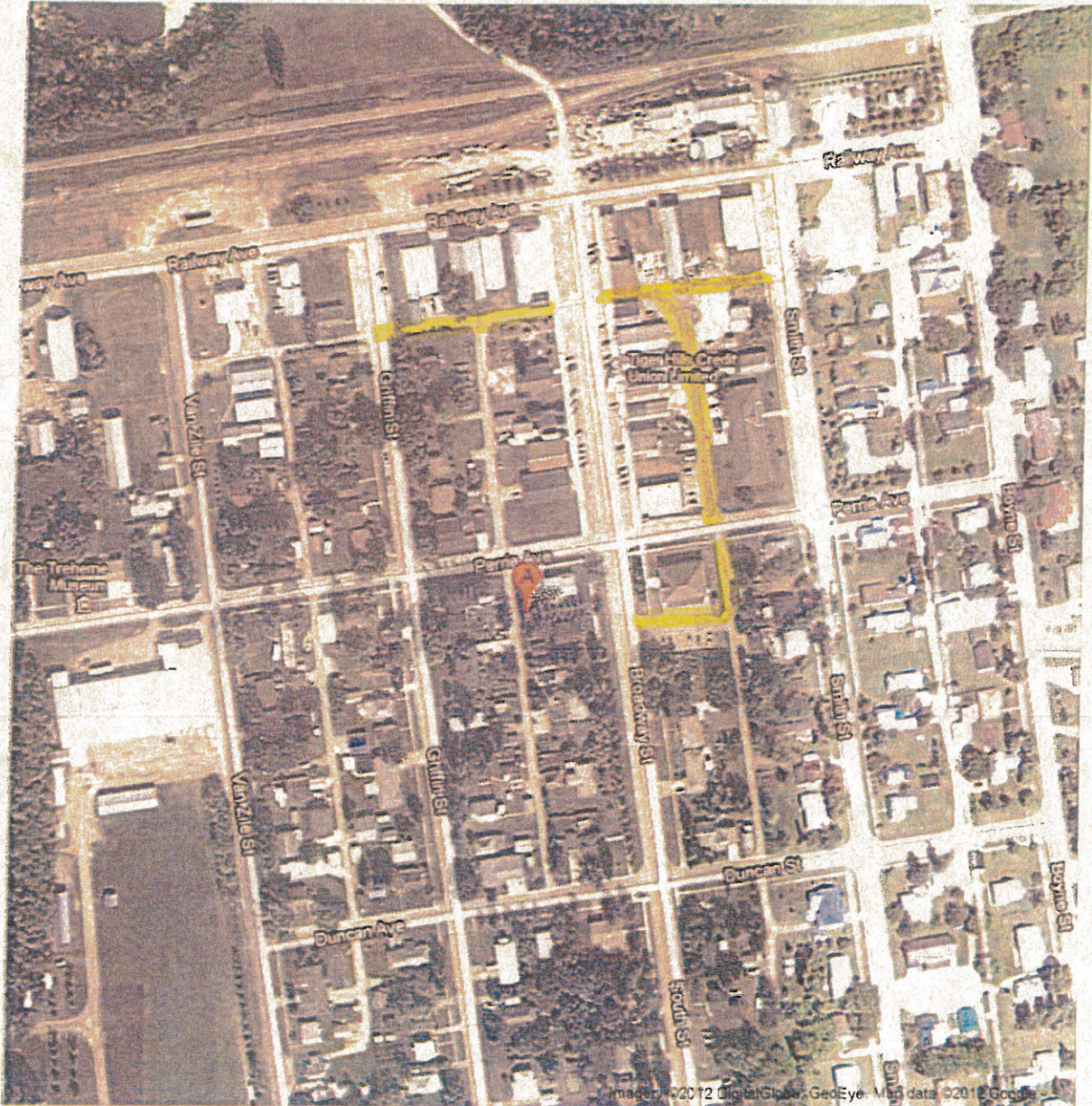

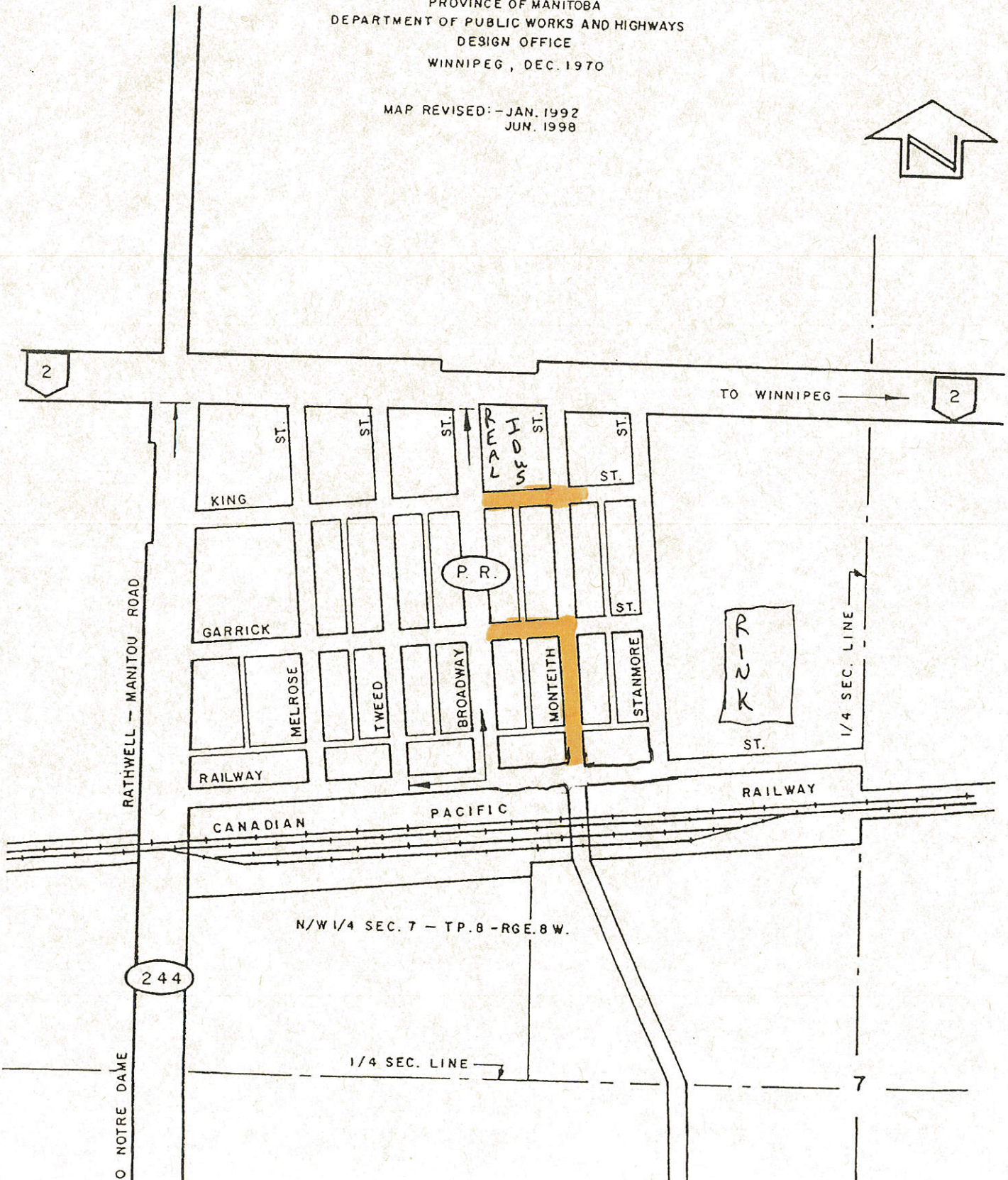

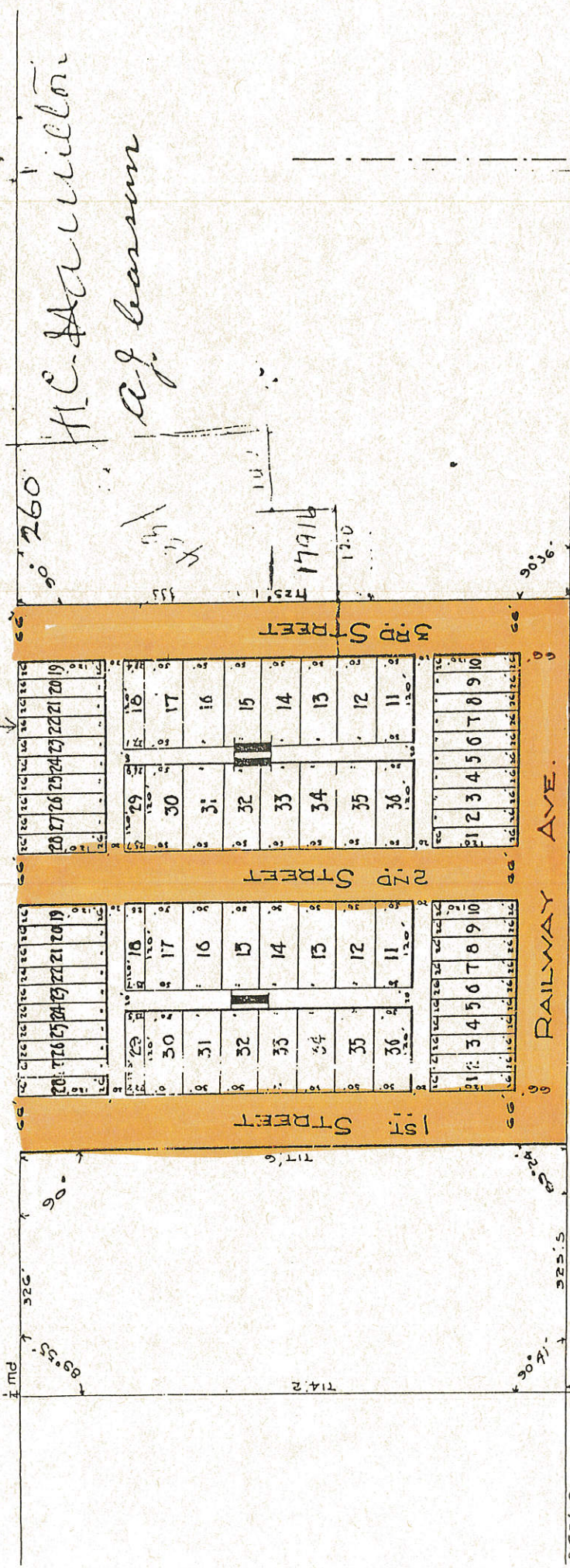
